## Every Day Quaffers

### WHITE

- 16 Sauvignon Blanc 2013** £17.95  
*Emiliana Vineyards, Central Valley Chile*  
Herbal and grassy on the nose with a really up front fruity palate of fresh grapefruit and gooseberry – "Really eco friendly folk, & they have Llamas – aah".
- 17 Muscat 2012** £19.95  
*Reserva Dry Muscat, Tabali, Limari Valley, Chile*  
A wine made close to the Atacama Desert, officially the driest place on earth. A perfumed nose with deep floral notes of rose and orange zest, chalky lively finish. "Felipe Muller (winemaker) has conjured up something quite addictive – be careful".
- 18 Chenin Blanc/Viognier 2013** £19.50  
*Percheron, South Africa*  
Vibrant and aromatic with delicious generous fresh apricot, nectarine and hints of passion fruit on the nose. A creamy palate with real fresh fruit flavours, fleshy just picked apricots with hints of guava.
- 19 Verdejo 2014** £21.00  
*Diez Siglos, Rueda, Spain*  
A complex, vibrant wine, aromas of freshly cut grass, nettles, passion fruit. A palate of peaches & cream with a pure long finish. "Spain's finest white grape from Spain's finest white wine region".

### RED

- 35 Primitivo 2013** £18.75  
*Conviviale, Salento, Italy*  
Fruit rich wine from the "heel" of southern Italy. Dark cherry fruit flavours combine with spice to create a lovely taste and texture. "Try it once and you'll keep coming back for more – ask Nigel & Marie".
- 36 Carignan 2011 - Fairtrade** £18.95  
*Koopmanskloof "The Mothers Block" Stellenbosch, South Africa*  
Sourced from the oldest corner of this farm, this bush vine Carignan has Christmas cake aromas, a soft, supple palate with cloves and black pepper. "Rich, fruity and complex Carignan from the pioneers of Fair Trade".
- 37 Grenache Noir 2013** £20.95  
*Pasquiers, Languedoc, France*  
A wonderful nose of raspberries, herbs and liquorice with a dash of white pepper. "Deep, dark and brooding"!
- 38 Shiraz 2007** £36.50  
*Killinbinbin, Langhorne Creek, Australia*  
Intense fruit aromas blend with liquorice, tar, fennel and pepper. Juicy purple fruits explode in the mouth, ripe firm tannins with a spicy savoury twist - big, huge even, but eminently quaffable! "Multiple award winner from the best vineyard in Langhorne Creek, the Metala vineyard".

## Reliable Classics

### WHITE

- 20 RIESLING KABINETT FEINHERB 2011** £23.00  
*Friedrich Wilhelm Gymnasium Falkensteiner, Mosel, Germany*  
Lightness & elegance on the palate with soft stone fruit, honeysuckle and lemon sherbet. "Feinherb is the new term for Halbtrocken or half dry - we'd call it off dry or just plain fruity".
- 21 CHENIN BLANC SAVENNIERES 2010** £37.00  
*Domaine du Petit Metris, Savennieres, Loire Valley, France*  
A wonderful example of wild Chenin Blanc, classic honeyed & almond aromas, a rich palate, lush texture with flavours of green apples, pears, cardamom, and marzipan. "Made by the Renou family since 1742! They know a thing or two about great wine".

- 22 Chablis 2012** £29.95  
*Domaine Gerard Tremblay, Burgundy, France*  
Hints of Green and Yellow in the glass with yeasty, flinty notes on the nose, leading to a rich, fat and fruity palate with typical minerality. "From the Kimmeridgian limestone soil rich in sea shells from the Jurassic period – that made Chablis famous".
- 23 Sauvignon Blanc 2014** £26.00  
*Bishops Leap, Marlborough New Zealand*  
Wairau River provides the ever so important water source for Marlborough's flourishing grape vines enabling them to provide pristine and pure wine. Distinctively Marlborough, this wine shows gooseberry, passionfruit and honey suckle.
- 24 Sancerre 2014** £29.95  
*Domaine du Pré Semelé, Loire Valley, France*  
The Domaine has 45 parcels planted on the classic "terres blanches" clay/chalk soils which give a full round style, unlike some of the weedy nonsense on the high street.

- 25 Chablis Premier Cru Vau-Ligneau 2011** £32.95  
*Domaine de la Motte, France - NB Awarded the Taste vintage label*  
A real rarity this – proper Chablis that has classic minerality and complexity, yet is full and has rich ripe fruit with crisp acidity. If you've been disappointed by Chablis lately splash out and your confidence will be restored.
- 26 Pouilly Fumé 2012** £45.00  
*Domaine Bouchie Chatellier Pouilly Fume 'Premier Millesime' Loire Valley, France*  
'Top drawer' Pouilly Fume, elegant and full flavoured.

- 27 Puligny – Montrachet Premier Cru 2007** £75.00  
*"Champs Gain" Oliver Leflaive, Burgundy, France*  
A rich dry white wine with delicacy and finesse from one of the most respected winemakers of the world.

- 28 Meursault 2007** £75.00  
*Clos Du Cromin, Burgundy, France*  
Olivier Leflaive's Meursault is rich and fleshy with notes of lemon meringue, fresh almonds and spice developing over time.

### RED

- 39 Cotes Du Rhone Villages 2012** £20.95  
*Les Coteaux, Boutinot, France*  
Made from a selection of the best wines from named villages, 'Les Coteaux' is given richness and depth by the addition of barrel-aged classified wine from Sablet, Cairanne and Seguret, matured for a minimum of 22 months in new and old French oak barrels.
- 40 Corbieres 2013** £23.00  
*Chateau Les Inferets, France*  
A classic blend of Carignan 40%, Syrah 30%, Grenache 20%, Mourvedre 10%. A great wine to impress friends, from a vineyard sat between Narbonne and Gruissan.

- 41 Fleurie 2013** £28.25  
*La Madone, La Reine de L'Arenite, Beaujolais, France*  
A heady perfume of freshly picked irises & peonies drift above the crushed berry fruit nose. Luscious, cherry flavours & hints of rose, a touch of spice & good depth.

- 42 PINOT NOIR 2011** £29.95  
*12,000 Miles, Gladstone, New Zealand*  
Full flavoured, easy drinking and made with passion at the Gladstone winery!

- 43 Barolo 2010** £25.95  
*Flori, Piedmonte, Italy*  
From the noble grape Nebbiolo, three years aging in large oak casks develops this wine with hints of orange on the spicy complex nose and a rich palate with sweet tannins and a dry finish.

- 44 Châteauneuf Du Pape 2012** £44.95  
*Château Fargueirol, Rhone, France*  
A great example of the famous Rhone appellation with intensity, purity of fruit, grace, power and complexity from the much lauded 2010 vintage..

- 45 Clos Du Roi Premier Cru 2009** £75.00  
*Burgundy, France*

Soft accessible fruit with an assertive structure. There is a seductive perfumed bouquet and hints of Chery and raspberry on the palate; the hallmarks of great Beaune.

- 46 Amarone 2009** £62.00  
*Pietro Zardini, Veneto, Italy*

Corvina 70% - Rondinella 20% - Molinara 5% Other 5%  
Intense bouquet of ripe fruit, shades of coffee, cocoa, almonds, griotte cherries and spices. Tiny production but a fantastic James Bond style underground cellar, a singing "Lion" - that's Dad Leone, nicknamed Rosignol as his voice is like a nightingale. Sorry we digress - it's awesome!

- 47 Amarone Classico 2005** £99.95  
*Pietro Zardini, "Leone Zardini" Veneto, Italy*

Corvina (70%), Molinara (5%), Rondinella (20%) & Croatina (5%) from the Cru Mirabelle single vineyard, aged for 6 years, dedicated by Pietro to his father - an opera singer and pruning maestro! Intense lifted ripe fruit, shades of coffee, cocoa, almonds, griotte cherries & spices. as with the 2008, but more - more concentration, more acidity, more tannin, more flavour, more spice, more more more! "At the biggest wine show in Europe 180 international judges voted this the best dry red wine in Europe 2012" NB Only 432 bottles made.

- 48 Vosne Romanee Aux Reas 2008** £110.00  
*Domaine A F Gros, Burgundy, France*

A beautiful mid purple colour with elegant nose, amazingly silky in the mouth with generous red fruit and well integrated acidity.

## Deliciously Different

### WHITE

- 29 Semillon 2008** £35.00  
*Reserve Semillon, Fermoy Estate, Margaret River, Australia*

Constructed like a Burgundy, lots of barrel fermentation in French oak. Rich and fat yet crisp & citrusy complex notes of green olives, toast & nuts. "A top end Semillon now ready for drinking and will continue to develop in-bottle".

- 30 Picpoul De Pinet 2014** £23.95  
*Duc de Morny, Coteaux du Languedoc, France*

Floral and enticing on the nose, exuberantly fresh on the palate with pear drop fruit a slightly salty edge and underlying minerality. "A real hit at one of our wine tastings, nicknamed 'La Bomba' because of its intense fruit".

- 31 TORRONTES 2010** £22.00  
*Salta, Argentina*

Salta, in the far north of the country lays claim to having the worlds highest vineyards with vines planted at 10,000 feet. Greenish yellow in colour with aromas of citrus and honey. Fresh on the palate with a delicate persistence. "Fed up with Chardonnay and Sauvignon? Give this one a try, it won't disappoint".

- 32 Pinot Gris 2012** £25.50  
*Mount Hector, Wairarapa, North Island, New Zealand*

A luscious wine from the southernmost tip of the north island, aromas of pear and spice an tropical richness on the palate. "A classy drop this, I was going to keep it for myself but it's good to share".

- 33 Chardonnay 2007** £30.75  
*PHI, Lusatia Park Vineyard, Yarra Valley, Australia*

Phi is a celebration of single vineyard terroir in the Yarra Valley. Fine structured wine, pale straw in colour, subtle tropical fruits. "Beautiful rich buttery flavour on the palate".

- 34 Sauvignon Blanc 2010** £30.00  
*Casas del Bosque Pequeñas Producciones Casablanca, Chile*

Intense grapefruit, white pepper and fresh ginger on the nose creating an intense palate of quince and peach with a smokey, flinty mineral finish. "A multi award winning wine – A Sauvignon for grown-ups".

## RED

- 49 Es Plantagenets Saumur 2010** £22.00  
*Loire Valley, France*  
Brick red with ruby highlights, delicately aromatic with a redcurrant and liquorice bouquet. "A lighter style of Cabernet Franc, typical of the Loire valley".
- 50 Monastrell 2011** £23.00  
*Aldea de Adaras, Almansa, Spain*  
A modern Bodega specialising in the traditional vines of the region. This is 100% Monastrell (Mourvedre) from steel tanks to new French oak barrels gives a full, fruity, spicy wine with soft tannins.
- 51 Reserva Carmenere 2013** £23.95  
**(Organic/Biodynamic/Fairtrade)**  
*Emiliana Vineyards Adobe, Rapel Valley, Chile*  
A dusty cherry stone nose, with rich black fruit, hints of spice & leafy characters. The palate is uplifting with cherries & chocolate, blueberry & mocha. "I've been going on about Carmenere for years – finally it's gaining a strong following".
- 52 Syrah 2011** £24.95  
*Odfjell Armador, Maipo Valley, Chile*  
Ultra ripe fruit combining great depth and richness. Oak underpins dark blackcurrant and blackberry fruit and sweet spice. "When Norwegian ship owner Dan Odfjell settled in a small corner of Maipo Valley, he raised a few eyebrows, now his wines are doing just the same".
- 53 Dona Paula Estate Malbec 2013** £28.50  
*Mendoza, Argentina*  
Our Malbec has an intense violet colour, pure aromas of black fruits, violets and spices and firm tannins balanced with fresh acidity.
- 54 P De Maria 2007** £31.75  
*Macià Batle, Binnisalem, Mallorca, Spain*  
A blend of Manto Negro, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah and Merlot. Strong aromas of red and black fruit lead to a smooth, supple palate, juicy and beautifully balanced with a long and elegant finish with a warm intense finish.
- 55 Barbera D'asti 2010** £35.00  
*Conan The Barbera, Piemonte, Italy*  
Made by Englishman, Graham Wharmby, aromas of dark bitter cherry combine with an earthy note, full, very ripe and concentrated on the palate. "With a name like that it just had to go on the list, the bold flavours match the name".
- 56 Cabernet Franc 2011** £35.95  
*Family Red Jasper, Raats, Stellenbosch, South Africa*  
Lucious blackberry, black cherry and plum with expressive notes of cinnamon, mocha. "A wine gently crafted with love, to be enjoyed the same way".

## Champagne

- 60 House Selection Gremmillet Cuvee Brut** £34.95  
Soft gently flavoured fizz, fragrances of butter, almond and brioche, easy drinking style.  
Glass (125ml) £6.65
- 61 House Selection - Gremmillet Brut Rose** £39.95  
Deep colour and flavours: think wild red sockeye salmon not farmed pink. Proper rosé!
- 62 Perrier Jouet Grand Brut NV** £50.00  
Succulent flavours of peach, exotic fruits, honey and citrus. A round & fresh palate with a long, lingering finish.
- 63 Perrier Jouet Belle Epoque 1999** £125.00  
Champagne of the highest class, great length of flavour and a elegant finish. One of the top prestige Cuvee's, served at the best tables around the world.
- 64 Moet Et Chandon - Grand Vintage 2004** £90.00  
Superbly structured and refined. Leans towards elegance with subtle richness.
- 65 Laurent-Perrier Rosé Brut – Tours-Sur-Marne** £76.50  
Deep pink colour, the benchmark for all roses – luxury!
- 67 Krug Grande Cuvée – Reims** £135.00  
Fermented in small oak barrels, it has an intoxicating nutty spiced apple aroma, is perfectly balanced and buttery fine with decadent golden bubbles.
- 68 Pol Roger Cuvee Sir Winston Churchill** £165.00  
A secret blend made in honour of one of their most famous customers, Sir Winston Churchill, to reflect his power and refinement. "Bloody Marvellous"!!

## Sparkling

- 69 Cintila Vinho Espumante** £21.00  
*Portugal*  
From the edge of Europe, this extra dry sparkling wine has been made from Portuguese traditional grapes grown on Pegoes. Intense aromas of citrus fruits and honey develop into a rich and biscuit palate with a soft, balanced acidity. Delicious!
- 70 Prosecco** £25.95  
*Selvaggio, Cuvee Graffiti, Spumante, Extra Dry, NV Prosecco DOC, Italy*  
A vivacious and palate cleansing style of Prosecco, backed up with hallmark, soft pear fruit notes. Not to be missed!  
Glass (125ml) £5.35

## Dessert Wines

- 71 Moscato Passito 'Pallazzina' 2012** £16.95  
*Piedmonte, Italy* 375ml Bottle  
Honeyed, rich and intense. Ripe Apricot fruit and a buttery toffee character hide behind the typical fresh grape aromas and floral Orange blossom notes.
- 72 Elysium Black Muscat 2012** £19.75  
*Quady Winery, California, USA* 375ml Bottle
- 73 VINA ECHEVERRIA, 2009** £28.00  
*Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc, Curico Valley, Chile* 375ml Bottle  
This late harvest wine has an extremely pleasant and complex aroma with clear overtones of mature peaches, apricots and honey, emerging from a delicate background of botrytis. These characters reappear fully in the palate, enhanced by marked notes of quince jam and creamy honeyed flavours enlivened by a good level of acidity.

*South Africa*  
A fresh dry Chenin with broad appeal displaying classic baked apple and zippy citrus aromas with soft delicate apple fruit on the palate.

- 2 Pinot Grigio 2013**  
*Dea del Mare, Sicily*  
This is a crisp dry wine that has all the hallmarks of a Pinot Grigio with citrus fruits on the nose and a refreshing palate of zesty green apples.

- 3 Riesling 2010**  
*Moon Bridge, Clare Valley, Australia*  
Lashings of lime with some floral notes. Dry with a refreshing crisp finish. This is a classic Clare Valley Riesling, which just gets better with age. "Great as an aperitif or a match with spicy food"

*The Cloud Factory, Marlborough, New Zealand*  
Alive with aromas of stone-fruit & minerals, flavours of guava and lime. Fresh, clean and immensely easy drinking.

- 7 Pinot Grigio Rosé 2014**  
*IGT, Pavia, Ancora, Italy*  
Fresh and fruity with delicate aromas of red berries. Crisp and lively on the palate. "Proper pink! None of that blush nonsense!"

- 8 Cinsault & Grenache Rose 2014**

*Les Oliviers, Pays d'oc, France*

- 13 Shiraz Cabernet 2012**  
*The Wrong Un, One Chain Vineyards, South Eastern Australia*
